Old Business

- Cottonwood Fish Passage Update & Change Order
 - o Culvert is in and complete
 - o Roadway paving will take place in late September
 - o Change Orders:
 - o 1/2 acre of native grass seeding is needed in disturbed construction site
 - Recommend site to be hydroseeded in two applications (next week and late October) – was originally planned as broadcast seeding by ACCD staff
 - A parking area expansion was created with extra materials area was graveled and rocks were placed to prevent vehicle access to other areas
 - W. Bezona offered his property for construction staging; fence removal was needed to do so and we need to replace the fence that was removed and we would like to add some additional gates and uprights.
 - The quantities for Crushed Surfacing Base Course was planned for 71 cy of material and the final was 221. The footprint for this part of the project was less than anticipated so there was a miscalculation in the original plans. There was an additional 150 cy of material needed.
 - The four change order line items total \$32,627.26. There are sufficient funds left in the grant budgets to allow for the change orders.
 - Jason Schlee moved and Jerry Hendrickson seconded a motion to approve the Cottonwood Fish Passage Change Orders totaling \$32,627.26. Motion Carried
- Couse & Tenmile PALS Updates
 - Crew finished installations on September 10th, staff will be out to monitor and make minor adjustments between now and the end of September (fish work window)

 - o Cultural Resource surveys needed for projects have a high cost
 - Megan will give the Board the expected workload and associated data

- Federal Tax Withholdings
 - o Deferment option for employers to participate
 - Deferring Certain Payroll Tax Obligations. The Secretary of the Treasury is hereby directed to use his authority pursuant to 26 U.S.C. 7508A to defer the withholding, deposit, and payment of the tax imposed by 26 U.S.C. 3101(a), and so much of the tax imposed by 26 U.S.C. 3201 as is attributable to the rate in effect under 26 U.S.C. 3101(a), on wages or compensation, as applicable, paid during the period of September 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020.
 - Employer (ACCD) decision: not to participate in payroll tax deferment option.
- > FLEX/Cafeteria Plan Midyear Election Changes
 - Due to COVID-19, the IRS has relaxed the rules to allow mid-year election changes to FLEX/cafeteria Plans. If ACCD elects to allow changes, it must be approved by the board.
 - Jerry Hendrickson moved and Jason Schlee seconded a motion to allow midyear election changes in 2020 for FLEX/Cafeteria Plans for ACCD Staff.

- Cougar Creek Fish Passage
 - Design project is on the funding list for the Snake River Lead Entity and will be approved at the September SRFB meeting. The RFP for the design will be going out shortly.
