

## American Cranberry Bush *Viburnum trilobum*.

**Distribution:** American Cranberry Bush is commonly found throughout the northern United States and southern Canada.

**Growth:** American Cranberry Bush has a moderate growth rate and are typically 8 to 12' in height with equal spread.

**Adaptability:** Cranberry required sun to partial shade and moist, well-drained soils. It suffers in excess moisture.

**Comments:** Flat-topped clusters of white flowers bloom in the late spring, providing nectar for butterflies and other pollinators. Flowers are followed by clusters of brilliant red fruit staying on the plant into late winter. New leaves have a reddish cast while fall foliage is yellow through red-purple.
