

Red Maple *Acer rubrum*

Distribution: Red Maple is native to North America.

Growth: It can reach heights of 120' and is a Zone 3 tree.

Adaptability: It will grow in a diverse range of sites and soils, wet to dry. It is also shade and flood tolerant

Comments: Red Maple is a popular shade tree. It is covered in clusters of small red spring flowers before leaves grow. New leaf growth is red to deep green, turning flaming shades of red, yellow and orange in the fall.
