NEW BUSINESS

The board reviewed the final Sublease Agreement with A and B exhibit attachments for the property located at 1397 Port Drive.

The board called Ray Skelton with Specialty Environmental Group to clarify that the commencement date is scheduled tentatively for May 1, 2022. If ACCD is not able to occupy the building due to supply chain delays, contractor availability or other unforeseen issues, ACCD will not be required to pay rent. He confirmed that if we are unable to take occupancy on May 1, rent will not be charged for the month or will be prorated based on the time it is available for occupancy in the month of May. In addition, if we are unable to utilize the full space, SEG will work the District to negotiate a prorated rent adjustment.

Kelsey Crawford moved and Jerry Hendrickson seconded a motion to approve the sublease, as presented in its entirety, between the Asotin County Conservation District and Specialty Environmental Group. **Motion Carried. 1**

Chairman Levi Luhn will sign the Sub-Lease agreement with SEG at a time to be scheduled to a notary.
