PARTNER AGENCY REPORTS

NRCS report from Mitch Ruchert - "As of now, NRCS has obligated 11 EQIP contracts for FY24, for a total of \$323,368. CSP workload is light this year for Asotin County, all of our applications were either cancelled or deferred to FY25. Chance and I helped with the CSP workload in Garfield, Columbia, and Walla Walla counties. Jacob has been busy completing CRP status reviews across all 5 counties in our team as well as helping Chance and I with various field work for the active contracts and applications we have. We have 6 CSP renewal applications for FY25 that Chance and I will be working on this fall. Our FY25 application deadline dates have been released. The deadline for FY25 EQIP applications is October 22, 2024, and the deadline for FY25 CSP General applications is January 17, 2025. I know in my last report I mentioned that a Natural Resources Specialist position for the Clarkston office had opened, and we did send a job offer to one of the applicants but unfortunately, they chose not to accept. I am hopeful that we will be able to fly that job opening again in the next month or two. My wife and I welcomed our daughter, Ayva, on the 22nd of June so the past couple of months has flown by! That being said, I will be going on parental leave (daddy daycare) starting August 19th as my wife starts nursing school at LCSC so I will only be working Wednesdays and Thursdays until the 2nd week of December. Weather Station Locations

Currently, ACCD has three weather stations streaming data across the county. The District has funds for 5-8 more weather stations. Purchasing additional stations will help to fill in the data gaps when weather systems hit different parts of Asotin County.

Jerry Hendrickson moved to approve, and Rod Hostetler seconded the motion to approve purchasing and installing six additional weather stations. **Motion Carried.**

SRFB Grant Applications - Construction Planning

Asotin Creek 11.2 will go to construction in 2026/2027. ACCD will work with USFS to determine if they are able to provide project materials. The bid package for 3.2 will go out in fall of 2024.

Fire Damage Inventory

While there currently is no specific money from SCC for fire recovery, ACCD will be assessing damages on private property focusing on natural resource impact and ag infrastructure from the 2024 fires.

WCC Crew Hosting

ACCD has made the decision to revoke the application to host another WCC crew for the 2024/2025 season. There were too many issues that outweighed the benefits of hosting the crew. The Board supports ACCD staff exploring options and strategies for hiring its own crew.
