Nanking Cherry Syringa vulgaris.

Distribution: Nanking Cherry is native to China, Japan and the Himalayas.

Growth: Nanking Cherry is a fast-growing shrub that can reach 6 to 10 feet tall and

up to 15 feet wide making it a great windbreak species.

Adaptability: It can be established in almost any growing condition and is very resistant

to disease. It tolerates drought and does best in full sun.

Comments: It produces a small cherry that can be eaten fresh or used in baking and

cooking. It also provides a food source for wildlife, especially birds.
